Language Objectives are “**how**” the students will show what they are learning. They are focused on the four domains of Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing. The ELP (English Language Proficiency) standards and the WIDA standards are sources of language objectives.

An overarching aim of teaching and learning languages is to **enable the student to become a critical and competent communicator**. The aims of the teaching and learning of MYP language acquisition are to: gain proficiency in an additional language while supporting maintenance of their mother tongue and cultural heritage.
